Submission Requirements:

1. **One Coversheet** with title of presentation, name(s) of presenter(s), employer(s), daytime phone number(s), e-mail address(es) of all presenters.

All paper submissions should have **two** copies of the following while electronic submissions need only **one**:

2. **Title** of proposed session
3. **Description.** 75-150 words describing the purpose of your presentation.
4. **Highlighted Description.** Include a 20-40 word description of your presentation which will be included in the conference program if selected.
5. **Audio/Visual Equipment.** A few overhead projectors and smart carts may be available. Please list any audio visual equipment needed. Attempts will be made to meet AV needs.
6. **Length of Time.** Indicate if your presentation will be 45 minutes or 90 minutes.
7. **Presentation Format:** Indicate if your presentation will be lecture, group discussion, hands-on workshop or other (please describe).
8. **Repeat Session.** Please indicate if you are willing to repeat your session.
9. **Subject Area.** Indicate the areas in which your presentation would be most appropriate: Infancy, Preschool, Kindergarten, Primary, Later Childhood, Teacher Education, or All educators would benefit.
